Your child attended a Kids Tech Workshop today at the library. Kids explored computer animation using a free software program called Scratch. They created characters that danced, moved, made noise, changed colors and more! You can see your child's project on the Scratch website at <http://scratch.mit.edu>. If you or your child would like to continue working with Scratch, the software can be downloaded for free (PC and Mac available) from the same website. You will want to download the version your child used at the library today, Scratch v. 1.3.1.
