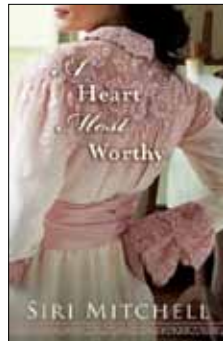

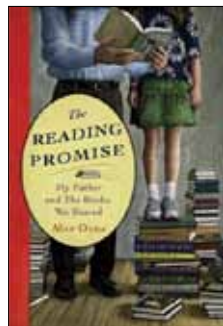
**A Heart Most Worthy**

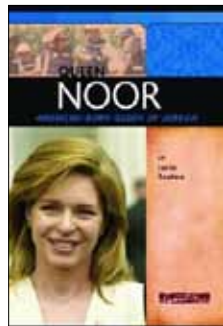
**The Reading Promise: My Father and the Books We Shared**

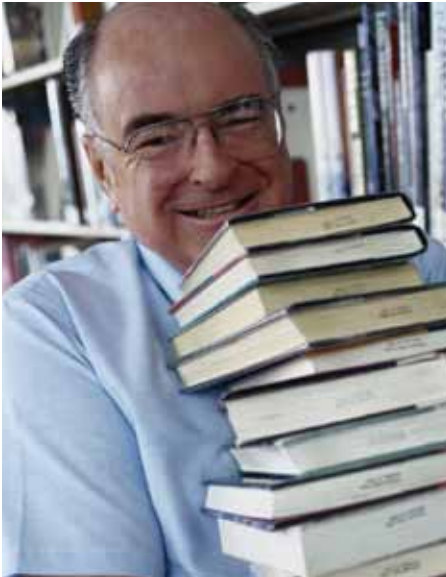

# Outreach celebrates Exceptional Service Award

**Hennepin County Library Outreach Services was awarded the 2011 Annual Exceptional Service Award by ASCLA (Association of Specialized and Cooperative Library Agencies).**



Since the mid-1970s, Hennepin County Library Outreach Services has provided innovative and outstanding service to county residents who are unable to visit and use the library due to age, illness, disability or incarceration.

By providing Deposit Collections and At Home Service to the homebound, the staff in Outreach Services are actively engaged in transforming the lives of the county's fast-growing, aging population. The number of people served by At Home by Mail and At Home by Volunteer has almost tripled in the last decade. Deposit Collections, which are delivered to 61 Hennepin County senior housing sites, have grown to serve a potential 11,000+ residents. The "At Home Reader" is published bimonthly and almost 3,000 copies are distributed. It is also available online or on compact disc.

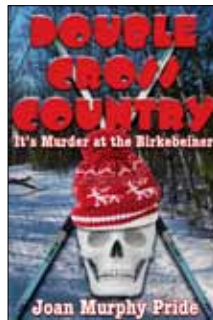
Innovative programming in Outreach also means that staff make visits to Hennepin County correctional facilities, bringing library materials to adult inmates weekly while also making materials available to incarcerated youth. Many unique programs are offered to help the inmates re-enter the community in a positive manner. The "Freedom Ticket" newsletter shares job and community resources while the "Read to Me" program gives incarcerated parents an opportunity to connect with their children. The "One Read" program brings inmates, librarians and corrections staff together to share a book experience.

In July, after winning the award, Outreach Services staff invited current and former staff to celebrate with a reunion. Also present were current Hennepin County Library Director Lois Langer Thompson and former director Robert H. Rohlf. Picture from the reunion above.

## Meet Author and At Home Patron Joan Murphy Pride

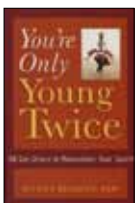
Asked about the inspiration for "Double Cross Country: It's Murder at the Birkebeiner," Pride says, "Vengeance. I was a poor skier out with great skiers who promised trails were easy and flat and who always lied. I said I'd get even someday by writing a mystery where the great skiers get killed and the beginner solves the mystery." Her first murder mystery takes place at Wisconsin's Birkebeiner, the largest cross-country race in the United States.



Pride grew up in the Kenwood and Linden Hills neighborhoods of Minneapolis, and graduated in journalism from the U of M. She wrote fashion copy for local stores, then copy for many advertising agencies. When her son was small, she began to freelance and write "Not So Fast: A European Grand Tour at a Mid-life Pace" with Phebe Dale Hanson.

Last year she fell and broke her back and that's when she found her new best friends: the At Home staff at Hennepin County Library. "I can choose my own books and audios and they send them to me. Heaven."
