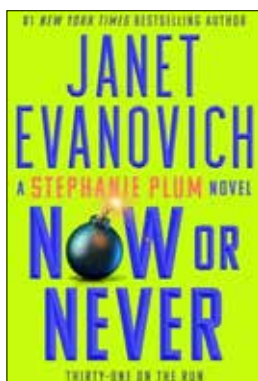

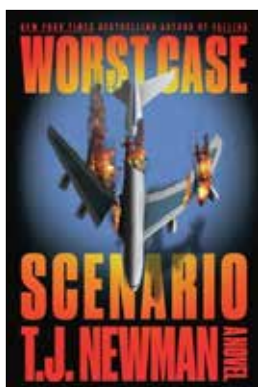
**The Four Winds****By Kristin Hannah**
